Core Concepts:

- **Six Sigma**
 - Improve quality through process analysis
 - Eliminate redundancy and inefficiency
- **Lean**
 - Elimination of any steps in process that are not critical to the creation of value for the client to improve efficiency and quality
- **Project Management**
 - Process for deploying resources to accomplish specific goals and objectives
