

Ordinances regarding response to Coronavirus

State of Florida:

- DeSantis Executive Order 20-68 (issued March 17, 2020):

 - Bars and nightclubs closed for 30 days
 - Beach gatherings limited to no more than 10 people
 - Restaurants required to limit entry to 50% capacity

Miami-Dade County:

- Emergency Order 01-20: Asking for the closure of congregate meal sites and community centers while directing County staff to take all appropriate measures to provide food service to affected locations.

- Emergency Order 02-20: Asking for food service establishments, movie theaters, playhouses and gathering places to close between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- Emergency Order 03-20: Asking food service establishments, movie theaters, playhouses and general gathering places (including gyms and fitness studios, but excluding grocery stores, pharmacies, gas stations, and convenience stores) to close, with restaurant kitchens allowed to stay open for takeout and delivery orders. <https://www.miamidade.gov/information/library/coronavirus-emergency-order-03-20-food-service.pdf>.
- Emergency Order 04-20: Gatherings of more than ten people in any parks, beaches or recreation facilities owned or operated by Miami-Dade County are prohibited for the duration of this order. <https://www.miamidade.gov/information/library/coronavirus-emergency-order-04-20-parks.pdf>.
- Emergency Order 05-20: No person shall operate any common used moped, motorized scooter, bicycle or motorized bicycle, or any micromobility device, on any public street or sidewalk within the limits of Miami-Dade County. <https://www.miamidade.gov/information/library/coronavirus-emergency-order-05-20-scooters.pdf>.
- Emergency Order 6-20: All parks, beaches and recreational facilities in the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Miami-Dade County are ordered closed. This order applies to both publicly-owned and privately-owned parks, beaches and recreational facilities.

- Amended to state that this order shall not apply to marinas and boat launches, docking, fueling, marine supply and other marina services. Miami-Dade County owned and operated marinas and boat ramps shall remain open from 7 a.m. to sunset.

- **Emergency Order 7-20:** Effective 9 P.M. March 19, all non-essential retail and commercial establishments are ordered closed. <https://www.miamidade.gov/information/library/coronavirus-emergency-order-07-20-businesses.pdf>.
 - Amended and restated to clarify language related: new and used automobile dealerships; university, college, or technical college residence halls; private and municipal marinas and boat launches, docking, fueling, marine supply and other marina services; hotels, motels, other commercial lodging establishments and temporary vacation rentals; veterinarians and pet boarding facilities; and mortuaries, funeral homes, and cemeteries.
