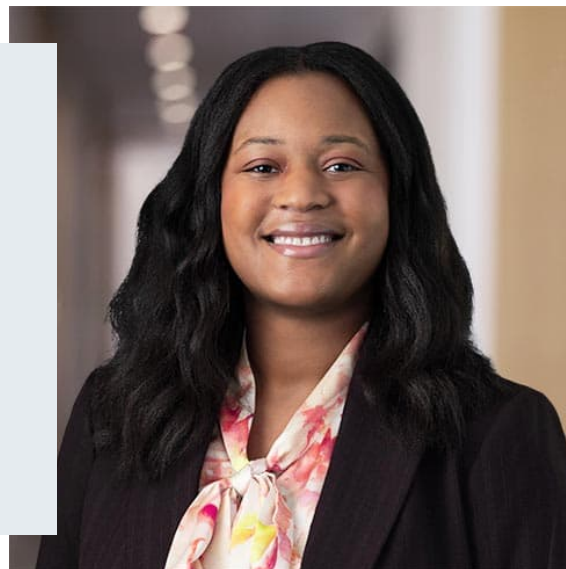


Breana K. Spight
