

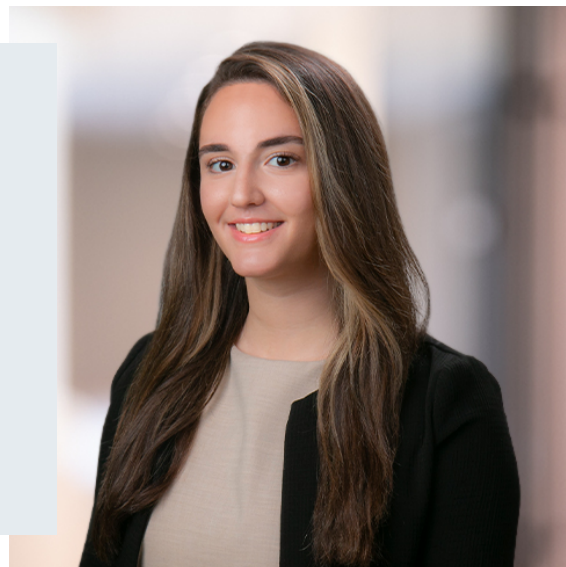
Ruba Assaf
