

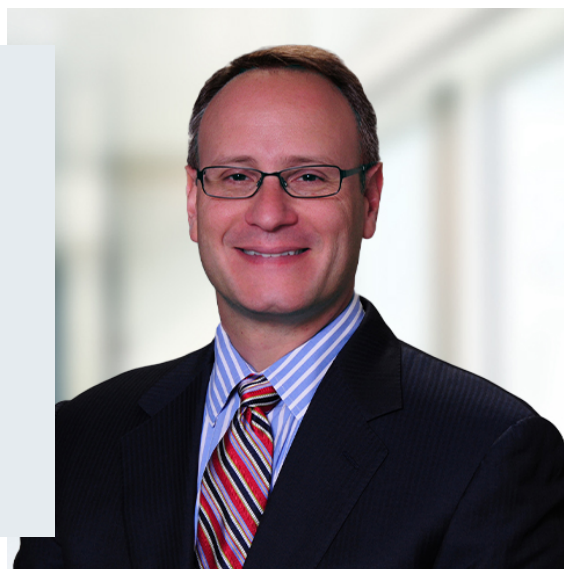
Christopher M. Cutler
