Kirsten also advises clients in responding to civil investigative demands and subpoenas brought by the Antitrust Division of the Department of Justice, including in investigations involving allegations of price fixing and anti-competitive information sharing.

In addition to her antitrust practice, Kirsten represents businesses in a wide variety of complex commercial litigations. Kirsten has handled complex commercial litigations involving, among others, claims of antitrust violations, unfair competition in violation of the Lanham Act and California’s Unfair Competition Law, copyright and trade secret misappropriation, breaches of contract, tortious interference, fraud, and vicarious liability and negligence for personal injury.
