

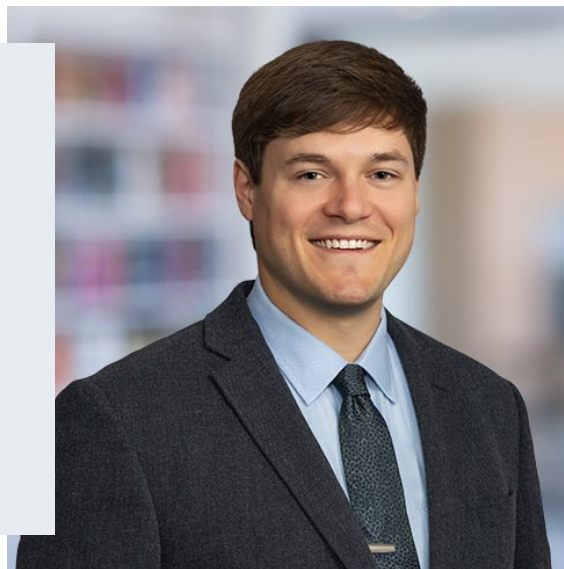
William C. Burch
